Stand Aside Positions:

- I. I have a personal conflict of interest that must be disclosed and that requires me to stand aside (abstain) on this issue.
- 2. My personal values and goals are not in alignment with the values and goals of the group on this issue, and I feel the need to be acknowledged, but do not choose to stand in the way of the decision. I stand aside.

Blocking Positions:

- I. I believe that the stated values, goals and capacity of the group will be seriously harmed if this decision goes forward. I must stand in the way of this decision. I block.
- 2. I do not believe that we have the unity required to implement this decision at this time.
